



## STUDY PLAN

Within the window period defined for each Academic Year (i.e., currently from 1 to 29 February 2024), enrolled 1st-year students must provide the list of elective academic activities they have chosen in order to complete 120 ECTS, i.e. the individual study plan. The latter must then be approved by the Academic Board for the Master's degree programme in CosmIS.

Elective activities can be identified among:

- all the courses provided by the University of Milan consistent with the educational project of the Master's degree in CosmIS (preliminary approval by the Study plan Tutor recommended)
- soft skills (<https://www.unimi.it/en/study/bachelor-and-master-study/following-your-programme-study/soft-skills>) previously approved by the Academic Board for the Master's degree programme in CosmIS (students will be informed about the selection)
- a list of distinctive free-choice courses of the Master's degree programme in CosmIS (strongly recommended)
- the Experimental Laboratory course that complements/integrates the research activities of the individual thesis project

Once submitted, the study plan can be modified in the subsequent years within a defined deadline.

As not all of these opportunities are open to 1st-year students enrolled during the AY 2023/24, we suggest the following procedure.

### AY 2023/2024 – Study plan submission

Procedure for submission:

- submit a study plan indicating **Experimental Laboratory** as optional course for **8 credits** (ECTs)  
*Submission will be available online through the Study plans service on your Unimia personal page > Study plan, from 1 to 29 February 2024*
- attend the special event for presentation of free-choice courses of the Master's degree in CosmIS that will be scheduled on Teams platform in early September 2024  
*Free-choice courses will also be listed in the 2024-25 Programme description (Manifesto degli studi) available on CosmIS website*
- arrange with the Study plan Tutor a reviewed proposal of the study plan, if needed  
*The preliminary approval by the Tutor is necessary because elective activities can be held before the time window for the plan modification*
- submit the modified study plan according to scheduled dates for AY 2024/25 (probably from 1 to 28 February 2025)  
*Please consider that, for the admission to the final exam, the list of passed exams must correspond to the last approved study plan*
